Our school is Józef Piłsudski Primary School no. 32. It is located in Radom which is 100 km from Warsaw – the capital city of Poland. It's in Masovian Voivodeship. There are 454 students, 50 teachers and staff.



The Patron of our school is Marshal Józef Piłsudski. He was Polish independence activist, military commander, national hero. During World War I he was one of the most important people. If it hadn't been for him, we wouldn't have got our Independence again.



There are 15 classrooms and a big IT lab in our school. Lessons last 45 minutes.



We spend our breaks in the corridors. There are a lot of boards which present achievements of our students. There are 5, 10 and 15 – minute- breaks.



There are also a lot of Cups which our students won.



In our school canteen students eat lunches during school day. The cuisine consists of Polish traditional dishes such as chicken soup, Żurek – soup with sausages and eggs, pork chops etc.



Our school library is as big as our classroom. There are a lot of interesting books as well as the Internet cafe for students.



PE lessons can be inside school. We play table tennis, volleyball, basketball, badminton and handball.
